INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

Please read these instructions carefully. Be sure you meet all eligibility criteria. Scholarship applications (including all supporting materials) must be postmarked by April 1 and mailed to:

Ineligible, incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Application materials will not be returned. Only scholarship recipients will be contacted—by June 30.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES: The Career Advancement Scholarship Application is the umbrella for three scholarships each with distinct purposes and eligibility criteria. Please review the purpose, description and eligibility criteria of the three scholarships below and indicate on page 4 the specific scholarship you are applying for. You may indicate more than one scholarship if you are eligible; do not submit more than one scholarship application. No applicant will receive more than one scholarship and all decisions are at the discretion of the scholarship selection committee and the Virginia Business and Professional Women's (BPW) FoundationSM Board of Trustees.

USE OF SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS: Funds may be used only for classes beginning after the date the grant is awarded by the Virginia BPW FoundationSM Trustees, but must be used within the twelve-month period of the award. Prior recipients of the scholarship can be considered for a subsequent scholarship but must reapply to be considered; prior recipients will not be given special consideration.

APPLICATION PROCESS: All application material must be mailed together [note--incomplete applications will be discarded] to the chair of the Career Advancement Scholarship Chair and postmarked by April 1. All information provided will be regarded as confidential. Each applicant must complete the entire application form.

Applicant must provide:

- Completed application form
- Three letters of recommendation from non-relatives, including at least one work related and one scholastic (if not available, explain why not). Be certain all three letters of recommendation are current.
- Official transcripts of all schooling within the last 10 year (but no further back than high school).
- Proof of Virginia Residence (copy of driver's license, voter registration card, a Virginia Tax Return or DMV identification card)
- Proof of US citizenship (copy of birth certificate, US passport, certificate of citizenship or naturalization, voter's registration card.) A photocopy of any of these documents is acceptable to accompany the scholarship application; however, applicant may be required to provide the original document for inspection prior to any funds being awarded. A driver's license is **not** acceptable.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Consideration will be given to the applicant's

- Financial need
- Scholastic record
- Educational goals

DESCRIPTIONS OF SCHOLARSHIPS

BUENA M. CHESSHIR MEMORIAL WOMEN'S EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP: The Buena M. Chesshir Scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to increase the skill of mature women who are employed or seeking employment; increase the number of women qualified for higher-level positions; and help women achieve economic self-sufficiency. This scholarship is named in memory of Buena M. Chesshir, Past President of the Virginia Federation of the Business and Professional Women's Clubs, Inc. and founding President of the Virginia BPW FoundationSM.

AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP: Awards will range from \$500 to \$1,000 for one year, based on financial need.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Each applicant must:

- Submit completed official application form postmarked by April 1
- Be a woman 25 years of age or older
- Not be a Virginia BPW FoundationSM Trustee, or related to a Trustee
- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a resident of Virginia
- Be officially accepted to an accredited program or course of study at a Virginia-based institution
- Complete course of study to obtain a bachelor's or higher degree within 2 years of August 1 following the application deadline (the scholarship may **not** be used for study at the doctoral level except for law and medicine)
- Demonstrate need for financial assistance to upgrade skills or education
- Have a definite plan to use the desired training to improve chances for upward mobility in the workforce.

KAREN B. LEWIS CAREER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP: The Karen B. Lewis Career Education Scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to girls and women pursuing post-secondary job-oriented career education, that is, training programs in business, trade and industrial occupations or an associate's (AA or AS) degree (this excludes education leading to bachelor's or advanced degrees).

AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP: Awards will range from \$500 to \$1,000 for one year, based on financial need. Funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, transportation, living expenses and dependent care.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Each applicant must:

- Submit completed official application form postmarked by April 1
 - Be a woman 18 years of age or older
 - Not be a Virginia BPW FoundationSM Trustee, or related to a Trustee
 - Be a citizen of the United States
 - Be a resident of Virginia
 - Be officially accepted into an accredited training program or course of study in Virginia
 - Complete training program or obtain an associate's degree within 2 years of August 1 following the application deadline
 - Demonstrate need for financial assistance to upgrade skills
 - Have a definite plan to use the training in a business, trade or industrial occupation.
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WOMEN IN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP: The Women in Science and Technology Scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to girls and women who are striving to enter or achieve higher-level positions in scientific and technical fields.

AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP: Awards will range from \$500 to \$1,000 for one year, based on financial need. Funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, transportation, living expenses and dependent care.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Each applicant must:

- Submit completed official application form postmarked by April 1
 - Be a woman 18 years of age or older
 - Not be a Virginia BPW FoundationSM Trustee, or related to a Trustee
 - Be a citizen of the United States
 - Be a resident of Virginia
 - Be officially accepted to an accredited course of study at a Virginia-based college or university
 - Be majoring in one of the following fields: actuarial science, biology, bio-engineering, chemistry, computer science, dentistry, engineering, mathematics, medicine, physics or similar scientific and technical fields
 - Complete course of study and earn a bachelor's, master's or doctoral degree within 2 years of August 1 following the application deadline
 - Demonstrate need for financial assistance to further her education
 - Have a definite plan to use the education in a scientific or technical profession.
