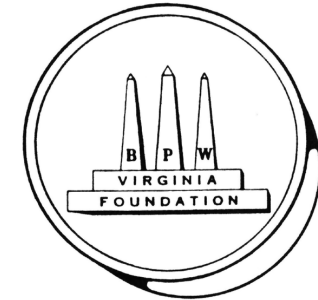

The Vision

Contribute toward the higher education of female students in Virginia.

The Objective

Build a Scholarship House on the campus of Old Dominion University (ODU) in Norfolk, VA to house nine female students at a significantly reduced cost.

The Reality

The high cost of housing can be a barrier to achieving a college degree. Low cost housing will provide students with a different form of financial aid.

The Goal

The House is the residence of nine academically successful upper class women in the fall of 2008.



Criteria for Selection of Residents Will Include:

- Must be a woman
- Must be a US citizen
- Must have a critical financial need
- Must be a full-time student attending ODU
- Must demonstrate high academic promise and achievement
- Must have well-articulated educational and career goals
- Must have outstanding character, integrity and citizenship
- Must be willing to share in household duties and responsibilities

Benefits to Residents—

- Low cost housing
- A home where they can:
 - Further their educational goals
 - Share leadership experiences
 - Develop life skills
 - Share family and community responsibilities
 - Become the successful generation
